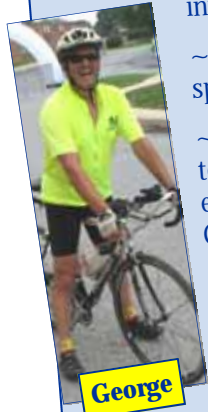
George Stoltzfus, retired CEO of Friendship Community, along with son Blair, grandson Jacob and wife Mae, will ride bicycles across the United States.

Endowment funds or restricted reserves are essential for the financial stability and longevity of a ministry like Friendship Community.

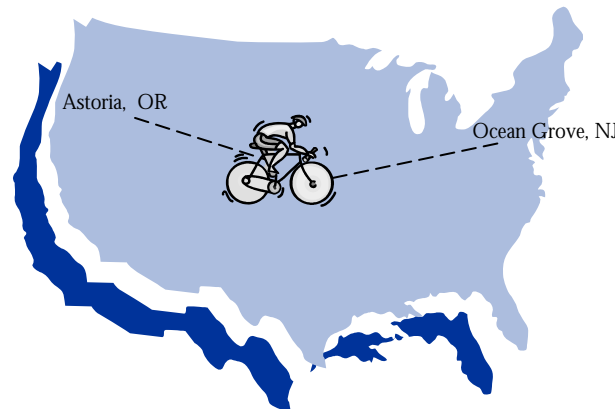
3.2.1 TREK HIGHLIGHTS
