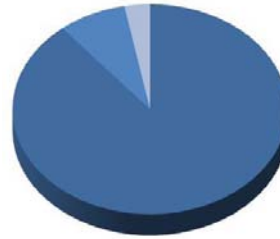
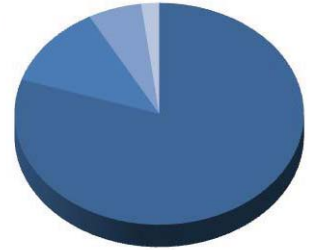
*Financial Contributions for Fiscal Year 7/1/09 - 6/30/10 \**
